Transport – Travelling to Southend-on-Sea

- **By Road**

- From the North via A1, M11, M25 & A127 (M25 Junction 29 - 20 miles)
- From the South via M25, Dartford Tunnel, A13 (M25 Junction 30 - 25 miles)

- **By Rail**

- Two direct rail lines operate between London and Southend-on-Sea. The journey time on both lines is approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour.
- Southend Victoria (Liverpool Street line) - operated by National Express
- Southend Central (Fenchurch Street line) - operated by C2C

- **By Air**

London Southend Airport - 2 miles from centre of Southend (5 mins drive) and 18 miles from Junction 29 of the M25

- London Stansted - approx. 40 miles by road
- London City Airport - approx. 35 miles by road
- London Gatwick Airport - approx. 59 miles by road
- London Heathrow Airport - approx. 78 miles by road

Old Leigh is an old fishing village just on the outskirts of Southend-on-sea, a picturesque, historical place, comprises of fishing boats, craft shops, pubs, houses, wharfs, marine industries and cockle sheds which stretch along the shoreline and High Street..
