To see their faces, the awe, the smiles as they gazed around them as they realized they could see their world now, was so overwhelming and heart touching I could have cried with joy! 

Agora is indeed also passionate about service.


ACI has brought change through positive action in the lives of those less fortunate on a local, national and international level.

CHILDREN OF THE DUMP

CHILDREN OF THE DUMP was founded in 2004 when two young Flemish visited the Stung Meanchy (Pnom Penh) dump site in Cambodia during their trip through South-East Asia. They were deeply distressed by the degrading circumstances in which young children try to survive by collecting recyclable items such as glass, plastic or aluminum. The children grow up living and working long hours in a dangerous and poisonous environment where even breathing is unhealthy. These children risk their lives for a few pennies.

A local charity helper Mech Sockha, who grew up on the dump himself, founded the Center for Children's to Happiness (CCH) in 2002. The CHH currently supports more than 130 children some of them only toddlers. The main target for the CHH is to protect the kids and create opportunities by providing them a shelter, healthy food, clothing, medical care and education.

During the ACI Conference in South Africa two of our Associate Member countries became Full Member countries: Congratulations AC Romania and AC United Kingdom!






And even more celebrations: During the conference, Agora Club Botswana officially became

my mind as a place requiring further time and exploration!




What a tremendous setting at Heia Safari Ranch for our ACI World Conference!


