AGM in Waasmunster/Belgium, on 30th June 2012

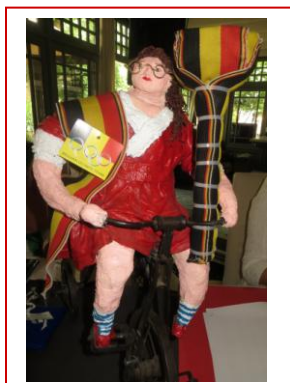

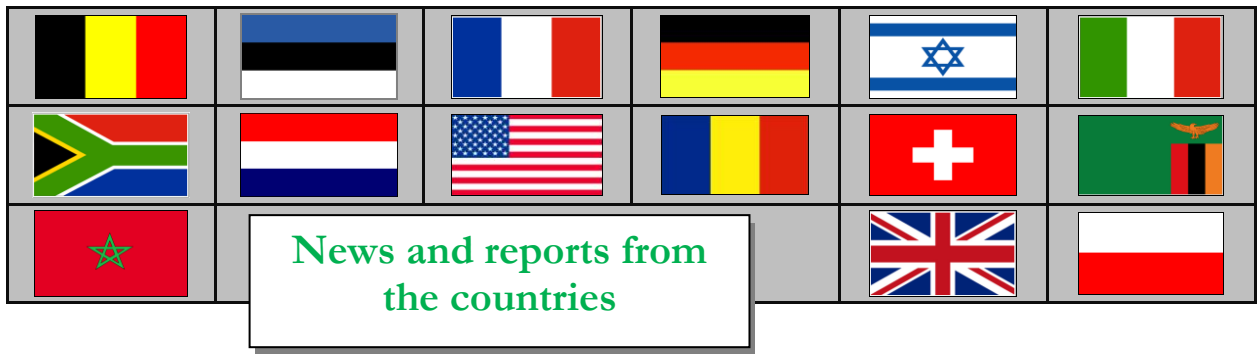
