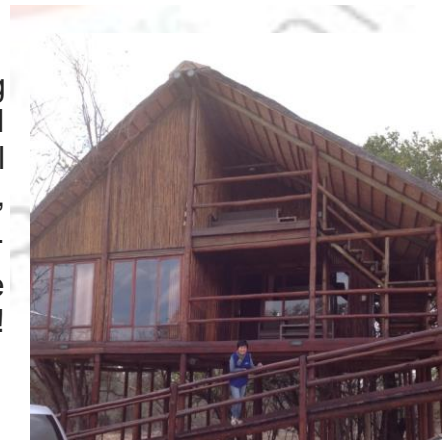


I relived, for some moments, all the things I’ve read on this hero. I deeply honored his struggle to lead his people towards freedom.

EYES FOR THE WORLD AGORA BOTSWANA September 2016



Botswana ladies, Kgomotso, Fuzlin and their teams prescreening 500 students from 7 schools, identifying children that needed the focus specs. Joined by Koen, Chris Helsen NP Belgium, and myself, we tested a further 831 children from these 7 schools plus an orphanage for boys. All in all 1331 children were tested, 168 children received spectacles immediately.

All 250 focus specs allocated to Botswana will be well utilized. The project is not quite finished as the Botswana ladies will be visiting the elderly and handing out focus specs to those that need over the next few weeks.

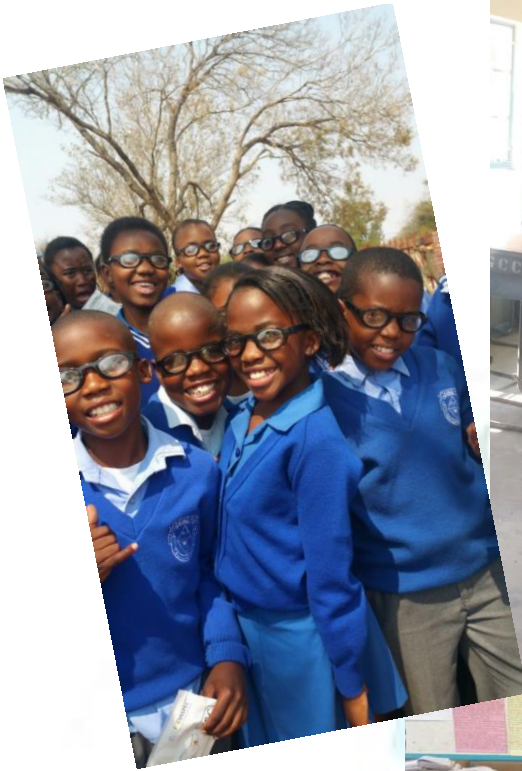

Cooking with refugees

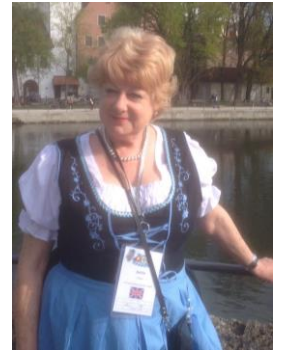
