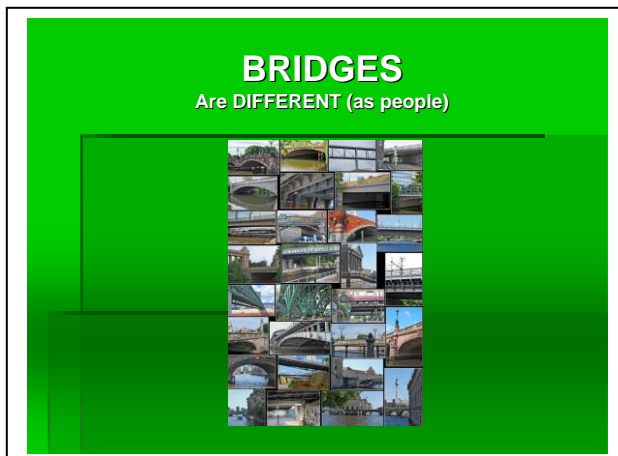

The Candle of Friendship is burning.

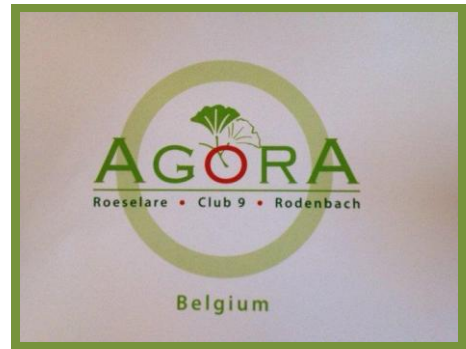

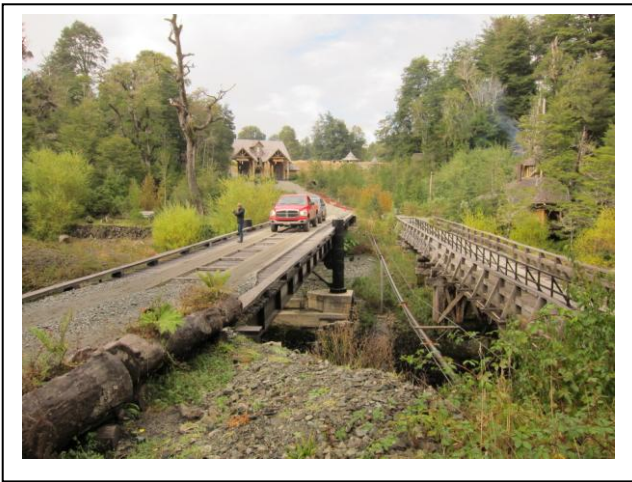

Bridges

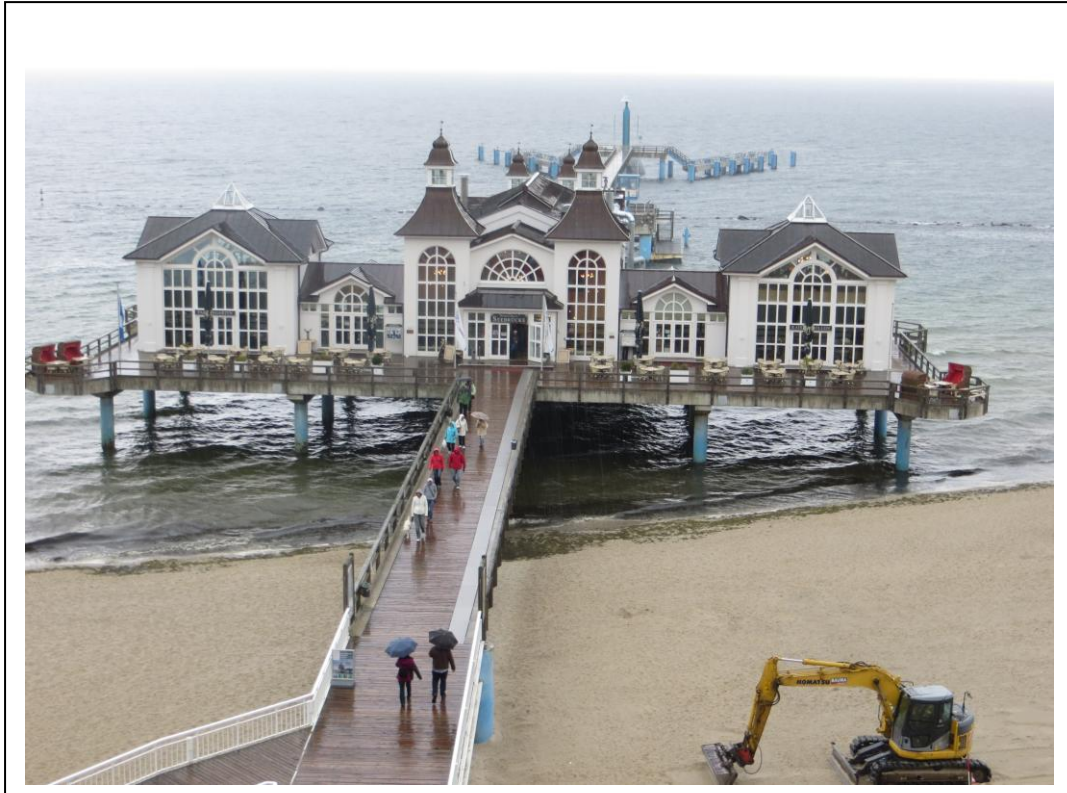
Dear ladies,
this is the last newsletter with bridges corresponding to Elisabeth's motto.



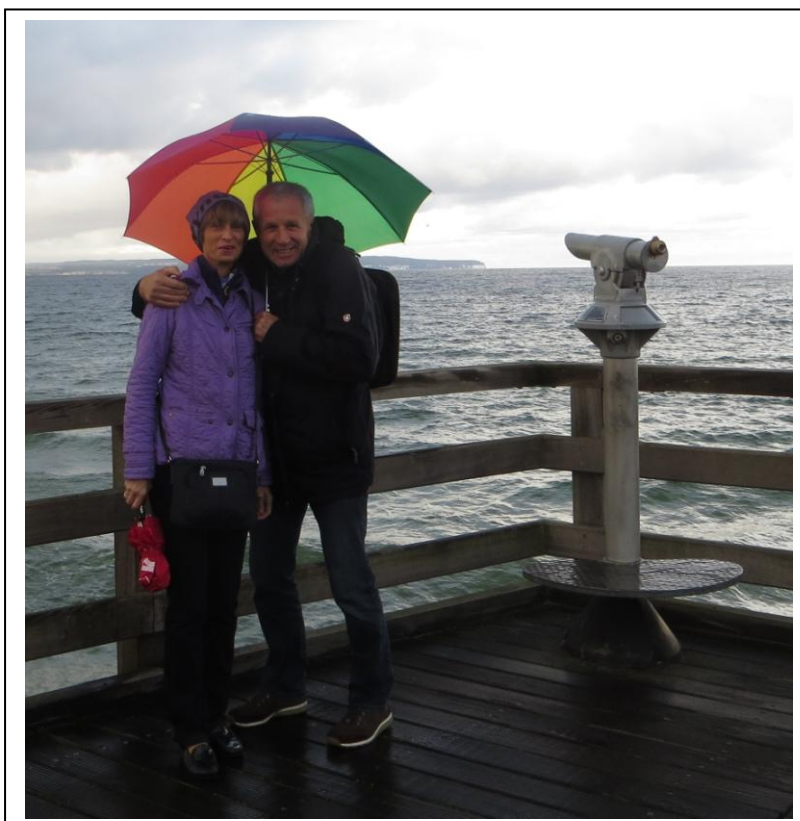
The above bridges are in Chile, below is a bridge in Toledo, Spain.
