


ACI DAY - WORLD OF AGORA CELEBRATE

International Prematurity Day

AC Romania – Side-by-side Agora Club- LC Romania

On 17 November worldwide is International Prematurity Day, a celebration of the victory of the little warriors borne before term, who succeed to survive and bring happiness to their family by growing and becoming normal and heathy children. One of the members of Ladies Circle Brasov, told us the story of her babies "one of them was big as a loaf and the other as a croissant".



A premature baby have special needs, a secure nest, warm in an incubator, with oxygen and all kind of special tubes, transfusions, special food and surveillance, for months, before he become a normal child.

Since a few years Ladies Circle Romania took the initiative to help some maternity hospitals by donate some incubators and every year they organize found raising and collect as donation all kind of materials as diapers, special moistures, baby-bottles, clothes, etc and the most important they organize in the hospital a meeting between mothers who gave birth recently to premature babies and mothers with children who were also premature, now grow-up. Purpose is to encourage, give emotional support and maybe advices. Also doctors are always very pleased to see how their ex-patients are running around, healthy and happy. Of course this year the meeting was on Zoom...

Since a few years also Agora ladies joined Ladies Circle's initiative and get more and more involved, so this year, despite Corona crises, Agora Club 5 Sacele obtained a sponsorship of 1100 baby-body of premature size and encouraged Ladies Circle 1 Brasov to distribute the little cloth to all Agora and Ladies Circle clubs in Romania to encourage to organize themselves similar charity actions, on benefit of their own town maternity.

In plus Agora ladies organized a a workshop, ordered 50 m cotton soft fabric, brought their sewing machines and sewed sheets for the little incubators. The two ladies from LC Brasov, Cristina Lengyel (president of LC Romania) and Roxana Dobre, initiator of "Casuta Prematurilor", sorted the little bodies and shared equally for all Agora clubs and Ladies Circle in Romania. It was such a nice afternoon. Of course not everybody could participate physically in the same time because of the pandemic, but we shared the tasks so everybody was involved one at a time.

Like last year this year the donation continue by organizing presents for mothers with new-born babies where we'll add also little hats, knitted by hardworking and talented Agora ladies through the Knitting Project.

The donation consist in : 6 sewing machines, 300 m of fabric, 3 large table for cutting and many sewing accessories. The classroom will be soon ready to be used!





Hello Ladies!!!

I hope you are all fine and keeping safe!

Since the ACI AGM in October 2020, the **ACI Board** and the **Convenors** of our **International Service Project** (ISP) Agora Club South Africa (ACSA) have found it imperative to **change our strategy** regarding the **ISP missions** to conform to Covid-19 regulations. Most of our countries are in and out of lockdowns

and large gatherings are no longer permitted.

After the successful **launch of our first 'mini mission'** in Louis Trichardt, South Africa, where 14 girls from Sumbandila Scholarship Trust were helped in August 2020, it was decided that mini missions was the way to go!



The year 2020/21, kicked off with **14 more girls** from Sumbandila, based at the University of Pretoria, being gifted with Palesa pads. These mini missions are proving to be a hit, as there is a lot more sharing, participation and interaction among the girls, which is usually lacking in big groups.











Early in the second year of the service project, **ACI purchased 386 buckets** from Palesa pads and we got a **rebate of 102** more buckets, bringing our total to **488 in stock**. 88 buckets, will remain with ACSA for mini missions around South Africa. The ISP Team are working hard to get the 88 buckets to girls in need as soon as possible! On Saturday 5th December, AC Kopano will be helping 30 girls from Megatong Primary School in Soweto and on 10 December another 12 girls will recieve Palesa pads in Mamalodi, Pretoria. The AC Kopano ladies are also planning a mini mission on the 12th of December. **We look forward to sharing these mini missions with you!**





I am delighted to announce that **100 buckets are on their** way to AC Zimbabwe! We are looking forward to the new activation in our third country.

In addition to the mini projects, some of the ACI ladies who attended the launch in South Africa were given (or purchased) a bucket to **donate to a deserving and vulnerable girl in their community**. On the next page are some of the first pictures of these special random one-off donations.

We are mindful that the ISP is an **international project** and as such ACSA are looking for the cheapest and fastest way to get the re-usable pads to **countries outside Africa**. If your country is interested in acquiring stock so that you can help girls in your community, please feel free to get in touch with the ISP Convenors for more information on how to host mini missions.





Our **Barometer** is coming along nicely! Todate we have helped **628 girls** and with so many mini missions planned, this number is sure to shoot up soon!

We are eternally grateful for every one of you who has donated so generously - every little bit counts!
