Impressions of Lübeck,

city of the ACI conference in Oct. 2012

Due to the lack of space in the 14 th century very narrow lanes were built in Lübeck. They led to the houses of the very poor people being situated in the second line. These special lanes are called "Gänge" in German. Nowadays still 90 of the originally 180 are left and have their old names. When they were built, there was only one rule to be kept. They had to be wide enough to carry a coffin through them.

Narrow Entrances to the "Gänge"









Behind the entrances people live like this



CASABLANCA AGORA CLUB 1 ACTIVITIES

The Agora members of CAC1 carried out a charity project in collaboration with the non-governmental organization Women's Solidarity (Association Solidarité Feminine). This organization is led by chairwoman Aicha Schenna, an icon of charity in Morocco and a woman with international fame, who devoted her entire life to the help of single mothers.

Our project consisted in organizing a circumcision ceremony for 12 babies aged 5 to 18 months, whose mothers are single and members of this association. Our club supplied the medical care, the traditional costume for these babies and even the traditional music band.

In addition thanks to the donations of Agora members, their relatives, their friends or mere acquaintances, we were able to give out essential foodstuffs to the 45 single mothers of this organization, as well as a significant amount of indispensable commodities to the three nurseries of the association Solidarité Feminine.

That April 6th was an unforgettable day for the single mothers, who got their babies circumcised, for the two single mothers, who got married that very day and especially for all the members of CAC1, who achieved a wonderful charity project in accordance with their values of social commitment, solidarity and sharing and caring.
